

DR-Go Quickguide

WARNING – This guide is not a substitute for the manuals; X-ray equipment is heavy and potentially dangerous. For your own SAFETY and to prevent damage read and understand the manuals first.

Normal Operation:

- 1. When turned on the unit will show the (**Ch**)arge of the (**CA**)pacitor as a percentage, then the (**Ch**)arge of the battery (**bt**) before being ready for use.
 - TIP: Save time by pre-charging the capacitor by turning it on for a few minutes at the beginning of the day, then when you need it, it may only take a few seconds to top up.
- 2. Set your exposure factors
- 3. Turn on the LBD either with the button on the control OR by double clicking to the 1st step of the exposure button.
 - TIP: LBD and lasers turn off automatically after an exposure or after 30 seconds.
- 4. Position your detector and patient
- 5. Ensure READY is displayed on the laptop, depress exposure switch to 1st (Prep) position. Ensure the READY LED is lit on the tube head.
- 6. Expose by depressing exposure button to 2nd position (the X-Ray LED will light up during exposure).

Troubleshooting:

- The unit will not expose
 - Has enough time been allowed for charging of the capacitor? If still charging the WAIT LED will be lit.
 - Ensure exposure switch is connected securely
- The display appears upside down.
 - Hit the R key to flip display back 180 degrees if it was pressed accidentally.
